
Path of Further Studies (For Secondary 5 or Future HKDSE School Leavers)

1. Full Time Study:

- Associate Degree
- Higher Diploma

2. Part Time Study

- Continuing Education Programme
- Employees Retraining Board
- Short Training Programs



Admission Requirements for Associate Degree / Higher Diploma

1. HKCEE 5 subjects pass (Chinese and English)
(or HKDSE, subject to further announcement)
 2. GCE O Level Chinese = HKCEE Chinese
 3. Age 21 or above
 4. 5% special consideration
- *** Visit the school and discuss with them



Employees Retraining Board (Non Chinese Training Programmes)

1. Short Training Programmes (Day or evening mode)
2. Financial subsidy
3. Job placement support upon completion of programmes
4. ERB Enquiries: 182182 (9am to 7pm)



Why Further Studies helps?

1. Invest in your sons / daughters for a better future
2. Better chance to merge with Hong Kong Society
3. Knowledge / Personality building



Local Paths

1. Full-time study in Associate Degree/ Higher Diploma
2. Search www.ipass.gov.hk for potential programmes
3. Apply to institutions in person after release of HKCEE or HKDSE results
(application fee, results slip, HKID card)




How Can I Afford Tertiary Studies?

1. Apply for government Grant/Loan
www.sfaa.gov.hk
2. Apply for government Non-means Test Loan
3. Working part time



How Much is Required?

1. Tuition Fee: around \$30,000 to over \$40,000
2. Travel Expenses
3. Food Expenses
4. Books /Stationery




Overseas Paths (much more expensive)

- USA / Canada: Community Colleges
- UK: A level / Foundation Programmes
- Australia: Foundation Programmes



Remember

1. Don't proceed to work immediately after leaving school
2. Your children have the potential for a better future



Can my sons / daughters support themselves?

1. Yes: if with full or partial Grant /Loan support
2. If No Grant /Loan: Suggest to study part time if family cannot support the students

2. Contact the Non-Chinese students support group
