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Development of NSS Curriculum and Resources

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Preparation of Schools in NSS Curriculum Planning

- Greater diversification of provision of NSS Elective Subjects in schools
- Majority of schools will apply Block Timetabling to optimise the number of combinations of subjects

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Results of Timetabling Survey

- Timetabling Survey in “Meetings on Preparation for 334 with School Leaders” from Nov 08 to Mar 09
- 246 Questionnaires collected (out of 268)
 - 91.8 % response rate
- 233 (94.7%): used data of students’ inclination to design NSS elective subject combinations.
- 236 (95.9%): will use “Block Timetabling” to implement NSS.
- 207 (84.1%): design the “Block Timetabling” according to students’ inclination

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Interface between NSS and Universities

- **Joint HUCOM statements to support OLE and SLP (Oct 2008)**
- **Further announcement of :**
 - (i) General entrance requirements (GER)
 - Provisional GERs have already been announced in 2006
 - Some institutions have refined and confirmed their GERs
 - The institutions are working actively with EDB to provide a second common announcement in Jun/Jul 09
 - (ii) Other languages requirements and alternative Chinese qualifications

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Interface between NSS and Universities

General recommendations

1. The GER will remain 4 + 1X or 4 + 2Xs
2. No institution requires the 3rd X in GER
3. Some institutions will consider accepting ApL courses as specified Xs for individual programmes
4. Other languages will be accepted as unspecified Xs in GER

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Interface between NSS and post-secondary institutions

 - Review of Project Yi Jin –for study after 1st attempt of HKDSE
- **2010**
 - Minimum entry requirements of sub-degree (AD, HD) programmes

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Interface between NSS and Employer Sector

- **2010**
 - Recruitment requirements for different civil service grades announced by CSB
 - On-going promotion to employers on using **Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE)** and **Student Learning Profile (SLP)**
