Preface

Purpose of Booklet

As a close partner with schools, CDI has systematically organised a series of Professional Development Programmes (PDPs) on curriculum development for principals and teachers. The purposes are to help them achieve personal learning goals, gain professional knowledge, develop pedagogical and leadership skills suited to the needs of their students and contexts of their schools.

To enable schools to plan and co-ordinate the professional development of teachers at the school level for the 2006/07 school year, CDI has prepared this booklet on “Professional Development Programmes for Secondary School Principals and Teachers”. The details are also available in the website: <http://www.emb.gov.hk/cd>. The programme information on the web will be revised or updated in response to changing needs and circumstances.

Design & Focus of Programmes

The design of the programmes are based on the need for schools to consolidate good practices in basic education, to prepare for “334” and responses received from school principals and teachers, including the number of training places required by schools during the consultation of “334” (http://www.emb.gov.hk/FileManager/EN/Content_4745/summary_pd_e.pdf). The PDPs to be offered in the 2006/07 school year would focus on the following:

- i) Teacher preparation for NSS subjects in the four identified areas, namely (a) Understanding and Interpreting the Curriculum; (b) Assessing Student Learning; (c) Learning and Teaching Strategies; and (d) Enriching Knowledge; and
- ii) Sharpening of teachers’ understanding and mastery of strategies to cater for learner diversity, to use diversified modes of assessment for improving student learning and to manage changes (e.g. managing interface issues, strengthening leadership and management for effective implementation).

Organisation of Booklet

PDPs in this booklet are organised in three broad categories: (A) Programmes on Management and Leadership; (B) Programmes for New Senior Secondary Curriculum; and (C) Programmes for Sustaining Curriculum Reform which include a variety of programmes on the curriculum emphases, teaching and learning strategies for the various curriculum areas and courses for specific groups of school personnel (e.g. new panel chairpersons, new teachers, librarians, laboratory technicians). Principals, teachers and other members of the staff may quickly identify programmes that may interest them through searching the first two columns of the tables which indicate the theme and the target participant(s) of the programmes.

The professional development opportunities offered by the programmes are desirably complemented by teachers' learning by doing in real classroom and school settings, collaborative learning amongst teachers in schools as learning communities.

CDI would take into consideration feedback from principals and teachers on courses delivered this year and continue to
