11.	Mother :	In your case, you can pick “Architecture, Construction and Town Planning”.
12.	Mother :	Then select the institutions you wish to check out.
13.	Mother :	The screen will show the number of “Publicly-funded Programmes”, “Self-financing Programmes”, “Other programmes on Qualifications Register” and “Diploma Yi Jin”.
14.	Mother :	Tap the programme type that you prefer.
15.	Mother :	You’ll see the relevant programmes offered by the institutions.
16.	Mother :	You may tap a programme to see more details
17.	Mother :	What’s more, you can enter your HKDSE Examination results.
18.	Mother :	The mobile application will match your results with the minimum entrance requirements of various programmes and shortlist those that you may apply.
19.	The Boy :	Hey, you too are searching for information on further studies?
20.	The Girl :	You’re right. Maybe we can get the advice from our teacher.
